COVID-19

The 2 positive COVID cases are off of isolation, however, there are ongoing symptomatic residents/tenants within the facilities that are being retested for COVID. They are restricted to their rooms until the COVID test comes back either positive or negative.

COVID requirements in common areas:

- Social distancing 6 feet apart
- When social distancing cannot be accomplished should be wearing a mask
- Wash your hands frequently

WE ARE CONSIDERED TO BE IN OUTBREAK UNTIL: November 20, 2020

The number of visitors will be limited to two (2) designated visitors until there are additional COVID positive cases in the facility. Then the number of visitors allowed in the building will be adjusted based on the number of local cases, if there are additional confirmed cases in the buildings, or other situations that may limit the ability to safely have more people on site. All visitation **MUST** be scheduled in advance.

Alberta Health and the CDC (COVID team) have imposed the following while the facility is in OUTBREAK:

1. There will be NO scheduled outside visits.
2. All residents / tenants should:
 - Limit movement between buildings:
 - Hillcrest Lodge
 - Golden Crest
 - Klondike Place / Jubilee Manor

- Movement between buildings for departure or screening (return) should be direct route with mask.
 - Hillcrest Lodge ↔ Klondike Place / Jubilee Manor
 - Hillcrest Lodge ↔ Golden Crest Manor
- Outside movement should be limited to essential ONLY, wearing a mask is recommended – groceries, medical appointments, pharmacy, walks etc. After leaving the building(s) ALL residents/tenants should be screened at the point of entry screening station at Hillcrest Lodge.
- Outside visitation for more than 24 hours will be screened upon return to determine low, medium, or high risk
 - Low risk resident/tenant must complete self checks twice daily for symptoms
 - Medium risk precautions must wear a mask in common areas for 14 days,
 - High risk precautions must isolate in room for 14 days
